There will be two panels this year at the State Festival. The Panels will be held in Texas Room #116, from 10:00 AM to 10:45 AM and from 11:00 AM to 11:45 PM

The first panel focuses on resources for club and Association officers. One of the most difficult parts of becoming an officer at the club or Association level is learning what resources there are to help make your job easier. There will be four topics covered:

- **ℜ•** The roles and responsibilities of callers and dancers when a dancer falls in a square
- **ℜ•** The Great Lakes Scrip program as a replacement for Federation Gold
- The TSFSRD insurance program: how it works, what are the limitations, what are the responsibilities of the
 member clubs and Associations
- **ℜ•** The promotional materials available through TSFSRD.

The second panel focuses on sewing and reusing, refurbishing, recycling, and up cycling square dance attire. Topics include:

- **ℜ•** Altering square dance attire that has shrunk (since our bodies did not grow)
- **ℜ•** Altering square dance attire into other garments
- **ℜ•** Making square dance attire from other garments
- **𝔭•** Unusual items that can be made into square dance clothing

I hope to see lots of faces at these seminars.
